## ETHNIC NATIONALISM AND REFUGEES IN THE FORMER YUGOSLAVIA

The Centre for Refugee Studies will publish a special issue of *Refuge* on the refugee situation in the former Yugoslavia. The issue will deal with topics such as:

- · Characteristics of the ethnic and national conflicts
- · Problems and conditions of refugees and internally displaced persons in the region
- European and North American response to refugee crisis in the former constituent republics
- The role of local and international NGOs in providing assistance to refugees
- The role of UN military observers in security
- · Reconstruction of the affected communities after the cessation of hostilities

Papers on these issues and other related areas are now being invited for consideration. Please send a short abstract to the guest editor by April 15, 1994. Deadline for article submission is May 1, 1994.

The paper length may not exceed 15 pages (double-spaced) or about 4,000 words. All submissions must include a 150-word précis in French (preferred) or in English. Short papers of 750 to 1,000 words are also welcome. Wordprocessed submissions may be sent on disk or by email.
